The **Master of Education in Learning Design and Technology** online (LDT online) program, designed for working professionals and delivered in a live virtual classroom, will help you gain the skills to design learning and instruction that drives equitable outcomes. Learn to apply current research in learning and motivation to enhance performance outcomes in P-12, higher education, military, nonprofit, corporate and other settings.

As the capstone project, you will design a learning experience for a real-world application that demonstrates effective application of theories and concepts.

Through the LDT online program, you will enhance your capacity to:

- Apply learning and motivation principles to create instructional activities for diverse learners in a variety of settings and cultural contexts.
- Select appropriate and accessible media to maximize the learning experience.
- Develop and implement a plan to evaluate the effectiveness of instruction in relationship to the learning objectives and in the pursuit of equity.

ONLINE LEARNING ENVIRONMENT

In the program, you will interact with student colleagues and faculty both synchronously (live sessions occurring in real time) and asynchronously (content experiences and assignments submitted via the learning management system). The live sessions are facilitated by faculty and include highly interactive, engaging and collaborative small-group discussions.

Applicants who complete an application by rounds one or two will receive primary consideration.
